The NDIS is managed by the National Disability Insurance Agency or NDIA.

If you live in **Wimmera South West** you will move to the NDIS from October 2017 to March 2018.

You will also be able to join the NDIS after March 2018.

Eligible means you meet the NDIS rules.

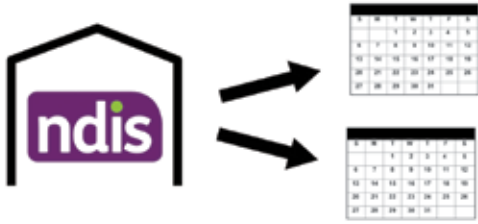

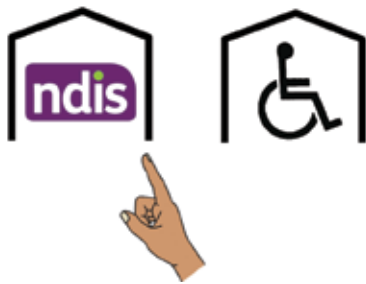
Wimmera South West includes the local government areas of

When will different services move to the NDIS in Wimmera South West?




Different services will move to the NDIS at different times.



If you get **more than 1** disability service you will move to the NDIS when your **first** service moves to the NDIS.

Services that will move to the NDIS **from October 2017**

- Disability Support Register or DSR waitlist
- Mental Health Community Support Services Needs Register
- Early Childhood Intervention Services
- Student Transport
- Attendant Care in Schools.



Other services that will move to the NDIS from
October 2017

- Commonwealth Government: Other services
- Commonwealth Government: Younger
People in Residential Aged Care
- Commonwealth Government: Younger
People in Home Care

People who do **not** get disability services will
also move to the NDIS from October 2017.

Services that will move to the NDIS **from
November 2017**

- Supported Accommodation
- Individual Support Packages
- Futures for Young Adults.

Other disability services will move to the NDIS
from December 2017.

Services that will move to the NDIS **from**
January 2018

- Mental Health Community Support Services
- Home and Community Care Program for Younger People.
